Apologized: Saying that you are sorry. Cognate: <i>Disculpo</i>
Audience: A group of people gathered to hear or see something. Cognate: <i>Audiencia</i>
Attention: When you watch, listen or concentrate on something. Cognate: <i>Atencion</i>
Confidence: Having trust or faith in something or someone. Cognate: <i>Confianza</i>
Embarrassed: Feeling shy, uncomfortable, or ashamed. Cognate: <i>Desconcertad</i>
Realized: Understanding something completely. Cognate: <i>Dio cuenta</i>
